**COULD THE FUNERARY TREASURE OF KHUFU
STILL BE LYING BENEATH THE GREAT PYRAMID?**

Impressive and majestic, the Great Pyramid of Giza, the only one of the Seven Wonders of the World still standing, has towered over Egypt for centuries. But a mystery remains: this colossal pyramid appears to be empty. Neither King Khufu's mummy nor his treasure have ever been found.

After researchers claimed to have found an "underground city" 600 meters deep beneath the pyramids of Giza in March 2025, the question arises: Could the tomb of Khufu be hidden under the Great pyramid - built during his reign?

Following the course of the Nile with leading international experts, and retracing the steps of the most iconic pharaohs, we set out in search of the treasure of Khufu. We will explore the king's pyramid, its interior, and iconic tombs, with the idea of a hidden treasure in the background, whose contours and location will be discussed with archaeological and editorial rigor.

SPARTACUS: THE MAN WHO SHOOK ROME

THE EPIC DESTINY OF HISTORY'S MOST FEARSOME GLADIATOR

In 73 BC, Spartacus, a Thracian soldier taken prisoner by the Romans, was sold into slavery and forced to fight as a gladiator. Breaking free with a handful of companions, he was soon joined by thousands of slaves seeking liberty.

Rome dispatched its legions to extinguish the rebellion – but the fugitives had already transformed into a formidable army. At their head, Spartacus revealed an unexpected genius for strategy: ambushing Roman troops, outmaneuvering generals, and inflicting crushing defeats. A military brilliance that came with relentless brutality. As his forces swept through Italy, towns were pillaged and thousands perished. After the death of his closest ally Crixus, Spartacus exacted a chilling revenge, forcing 300 Roman prisoners to fight to the death like gladiators.

But after two years of astonishing victories, the tide turned. Trapped by converging legions, and refusing to surrender, Spartacus chose to fight a final battle – determined that, if he was to die, it would be as a free man.

Carried by AI-driven cinematic reconstructions and insights from leading experts, this film tells the epic rise and tragic fall of the man who defied the most powerful military machine of the ancient world and whose name became a legend.

UNLOCKING THE SECRETS OF THE WORLD'S FIRST SUPERPOWER

It was the first superpower in history. A formidable empire that stretched its power from the Mediterranean to the frontiers of Iran, from the high plateaus of Anatolia to the lands of Egypt. Yet, until recently, it remained largely unknown.

Who were the Assyrians really? And how did they build, from Assur – a modest city-state of humble beginnings – one of the most powerful and feared empires of the ancient world, ruled by a dynasty of warrior-kings? Today, teams of archaeologists from around the world are conducting an unprecedented investigation to unlock the mysteries of this ancient civilization. In the course of their research, another truth emerges: that of a hinterland shaped by a monumental system of waterworks, where canals and aqueducts made water the secret weapon of the Assyrian cities.

A CENTURY OF VIKING INVASION IN THE FRANKISH KINGDOM

841: A fleet of longships enters the mouth of the Seine. For the first time, Vikings venture into the heart of the Frankish kingdom, but the king is not concerned: the major cities lie far from the coasts, and Paris, set deep inland, seems out of reach. An illusion... For from the North, the Vikings grow bolder.

Led by the formidable Ragnar Lodbrok, hordes of warriors push ever deeper into the heart of France, plundering the land - and even seeking to settle there permanently.

How did they outmaneuver its defense systems and impose their power at the core of French territories? How did they conquer Normandy and turn it into one of the most powerful duchies in Europe?

For a long time, the history of the Vikings in France remained fragmentary, but in recent years, archaeological excavations and scientific studies have shed new light on this great conquest. THE OVERLOOKED STORY OF THE JAPANESE SOLDIERS WHO SACRIFICED FOR THEIR COUNTRY

During the Pacific War, special units of the Japanese Army organized suicide missions in an attempt to halt the US Navy's advance toward Japan. In total, no fewer than 4,000 pilots would plunge their planes into American ships at the cost of their lives.

Since the 1930s, militarist culture had permeated Japanese society and its soldiers. On this fertile ground, a subtle form of conditioning enabled the psychological subjugation of many young men during the Second World War. The kamikaze mission quickly became central to Japan's counteroffensive. It would last ten months, up to the very last day of the war.

Blending previously unseen archives, letters, poems, and wills written by pilots just before their ultimate mission, as well as the written accounts of those who survived, this documentary evokes the sacrifice of these kamikaze pilots in the name of a war lost from the start and tells the story from within of this little-known, large-scale operation.

THE UNKNOWN STORY OF THE INTERNATIONAL COALITION, THAT CRACKED THE IMPENETRABLE NAZI CODE SYSTEM

Like a presage of today's era of cyber warfare, a fierce battle raged during the Second World War to break the first mechanical cipher in history: the Enigma machine. Everyone has heard of Enigma, and of the brilliant British mathematician Alan Turing, who changed the course of history by cracking Nazi radio communications.

But few realize that to crack the impenetrable code system used by the Nazis, a veritable army of shortwave specialists – French, Polish and British intelligence agents, mathematicians, and cryptographers – coordinated their capabilities in an unprecedented and largely unsung pan-European effort.

This ambitious miniseries sets out to cast new light on a history that is resolutely pan-European – one that has long been obscured by excessively nationalistic accounts of the Second World War. Only now are the achievements of these unsung heroes beginning to receive the recognition they deserve. Today, historians and experts from Poland, Great Britain, France and Germany, are joining forces to recover and celebrate the bonds that once united the protagonists of this extraordinary story.

MAO, WHEN CHINA SEES RED

EXPLORING THE RISE, RULE AND LEGACY OF CHAIRMAN MAO

In September 2026, China will commemorate the 50th anniversary of Mao's death. Half a century on, the founder of the People's Republic of China remains officially untouchable – his portrait still hanging in Tiananmen Square.

His struggle to build a communist society came at a terrible price: purges, famine, prison labor, repression, and mass executions. In human terms, his rule was one of the deadliest of the 20th century. How did Mao Zedong impose his vision on hundreds of millions of Chinese? Why did he enjoy such widespread support in the West during his lifetime? And how does his legacy continue to shape China today?

Through archive images and exclusive first-hand accounts of people who lived under Mao – including former Red Guards –, filmmaker Serge de Sampigny chronicles the rise and rule of the “Great Helmsman”, while exploring his legacy in a contemporary China currently rivaling the United States as a global superpower.

ELISABETTA SIRANI: QUEEN OF THE BAROQUE

THE STORY OF A VIRTUOSA WHO BROKE BARRIERS FOR WOMEN IN ART

17th-century Bologna stood apart from other Italian cities by the place it allowed women in society, defying the conventions of the time. The city boasted three times as many professional women artists as either Rome or Venice, and twice as many as Florence. What's more, not all of them came from elite families. What made this sort of progress possible here, and not elsewhere?

At the time, one young Bolognese woman painter broke into a field long dominated by men: history painting - considered the most prestigious genre of all. Through technical skill, and a network of intellectuals and patrons, Elisabetta Sirani drew commissions from across Europe. A true pioneer who died prematurely at the young age of 27, her work - long overlooked - is now being brought back into the public eye.

Blending animation, rare archives, and interviews with experts, this film reveals how a unique cultural setting and an extraordinary individual converged to challenge the social order and pave the way for women's emancipation.

YIDDISHLAND: THE LAST GENERATION

A RARE GLIMPSE INTO THE LIVES OF YOUNG EUROPEAN JEWS IN THE YEARS BEFORE THE HOLOCAUST

In the 1930s, a contest for the “best autobiography by a young Jewish person” was launched across Jewish communities in Central and Western Europe. Hundreds of young people between the ages of 16 and 22 submitted entries.

Hidden during the Second World War by the “paper brigade” – a group of Jewish resistance fighters – these manuscripts emerged from oblivion in 2017 in the city of Vilnius, among 180,000 pages of Yiddish-language documents. They are voices that bring us into the inner world of the last generation of teenagers to grow up in “Yiddishland” – a borderless cultural space at the heart of Europe that was home to 11 million Jews –, with all their anxieties, inner conflicts, and dreams.

A polyphonic narrative weaving their words together with archival documents, excerpts from Yiddish cinema, and amateur films from this time, this documentary offers a rare window into the lives of European Jewish communities in the final years before the Holocaust.

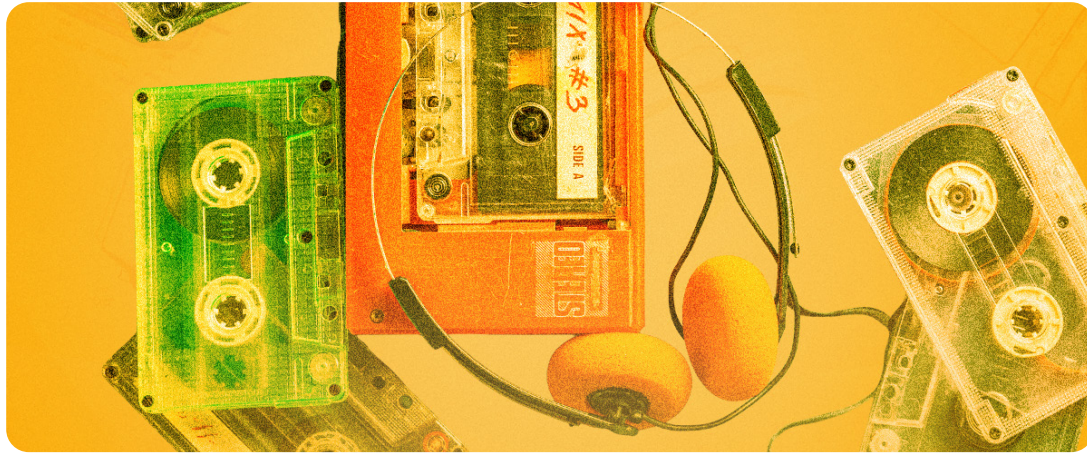

THE UNTOLD BATTLE BEHIND THE DEVICE THAT CHANGED MUSIC FOREVER

In the early 1970s, moving between São Paulo, Milan, London, and Germany, Andreas Pavel invented the Stereobelt, the world's first personal stereo player. When the Japanese company Sony began selling its famous Walkman in 1979, a 20-year legal battle broke out between this unknown inventor and one of the most powerful electronics multinationals.

During this astounding trial, Pavel defended the perspective of someone who had achieved his vision - in which a device freed humanity to listen to music anywhere and anytime - nearly ten years before Sony introduced the Walkman. How did this unknown man, who claimed he was dispossessed by the multinational, successfully assert his rights?

Pavel looks back at this little-known battle, and gives us access to his personal archives. Now freed of their duty of confidentiality, the lawyers who were involved reveal what truly happened behind the scenes. In exploring this extraordinary case of a modern David vs. Goliath - a complex affair full of twists and turns - the film focuses on the true origin of an invention that revolutionized our relation to music.

THE GENIUS COUPLE WHO SECRETLY CREATED THE FRENCH ATOMIC BOMB

The story of the French atomic bomb is one of the Republic's best-kept secrets. Behind this epic story, which began with the discovery of artificial radioactivity and culminated in the dropping of the first French atomic bomb in Algeria, lies a couple of geniuses: Irène and Frédéric Joliot-Curie.

It's an extraordinary adventure, rarely told, spanning the tormented years between the wars, the Second World War and the Cold War, with its division of the world into two blocs. The story combines spectacular scientific discoveries, crucial military and geopolitical stakes, hopes, tragedies, secrets and the intimate wanderings of the couple behind this decisive breakthrough.

With its innovative direction - a mix of fictional sequences, archival sound recordings performed by actors, and a hybrid narrative featuring real/fake interviews with the Joliot-Curies - this series will reveal the dramatic tension at the heart of this visionary duo.

HOW SCIENCE REVOLUTIONIZED CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS

In the late 19th century, science emerged as a revolutionary tool in criminal investigations. Pioneered by international experts, this new approach propelled solving crimes into a brand-new era.

From Paris to London, from Graz to Buenos Aires, a handful of pioneers developed groundbreaking methods that included fingerprinting, ballistics analysis, anthropometry, and the interpretation of physical analysis to create what is now known as forensic science. Every criminal case became an innovative laboratory that transformed judicial investigation. Physical evidence replaced confessions as the cornerstones of truth, championed by strong personalities. Felons now engaged in a cat-and-mouse game with these first “experts” of forensic criminology, and each case advanced the body of knowledge that is still used today.

THE MAJOR DISCOVERY OF THE WORLD'S OLDEST JEWELRY RAISES QUESTIONS ABOUT OUR ORIGINS

In a lost cave in southern Morocco, a team of scientists has uncovered what could be the oldest piece of jewelry known to humanity. These tiny perforated shells, decorated and worn as adornments 150,000 years ago, are revolutionizing our understanding of the emergence of symbols, art, and culture in Homo sapiens.

These ornaments may well constitute the first tangible evidence of symbolic behavior, challenging our assumptions and potentially repositioning North Africa as a central cradle of human innovation in Prehistory. Through ongoing excavations, we follow the trail of a major archaeological discovery, revealing how a modest artifact can overturn an entire narrative about our origins.

EUROPE BELIEVED IT HAD BANISHED WAR FROM ITS HORIZON BUT MUST ONCE AGAIN THINK OF ITSELF AS A POWER

Thirty-five years after the euphoria of 1989 and the promise of perpetual peace founded on trade, Europe is discovering that it must once again think of itself as a power. The invasion of Ukraine, the return of Russian imperial logic, and the American shift have shattered the illusion of a Europe protected by History.

WITH THE LACK OF DONORS, XENOTRANSPLANTATION CAN BE A SOLUTION TO SAVE MORE HUMAN LIVES

In 2022, surgeons at the University of Maryland Medical School achieved a medical miracle with the first successful transplant of a heart from a genetically modified pig into a man with incurable heart disease. Three years later, a woman - Towana Looney - broke records by becoming the first recipient of a pig kidney to live for more than two months.

Faced with a lack of donors, science is now considering transplanting an animal organ into a human. The risks of rejection and infection are among the many scientific challenges to be overcome. Other essential questions arise: Where is the ethical limit on manipulating the boundaries between humans and animals? Does the future of xenografts lie in breeding genetically modified pigs, or in growing human organs in pig bodies? What would be the consequences for the pig graft market?

In the USA, over 100,000 patients are currently waiting for an organ transplant. Every day in Europe, 18 patients who are candidates for organ transplants die for lack of donor organs. This scientific investigation reveals the inner workings of these medical advances, with their considerable ethical, human and economic consequences.
