AN ARCHAEOLOGICAL EPIC UNRAVELS THE MYSTERIES OF EGYPT'S SUNKEN CITY

3,000 years ago, at the mouth of the Nile, stood a sumptuous, cosmopolitan and thriving port city: Thonis-Heracleion, symbol of the power and glory of ancient Egypt. Swallowed up by the waters of the Mediterranean in the 2^{nd} century BC following a series of natural disasters, the city became a distant legend... until an exceptional discovery was made in the early 2000s.

In 2001, explorer Franck Goddio and his team brought archaeological remains to the surface of the Abu Qir Bay, including a two-meter stele. Since then, they have been exhuming treasures year after year – each more fascinating than the last. Today, we are embarking on one of the last expeditions of this prodigious mission.

With exclusive access to the current excavations, and thanks to the recent digitization of underwater archives and 3D reconstruction, this archaeological and scientific epic will bring this Egyptian Atlantis back to life and unravel its enduring mysteries.

THE PURSUIT OF KHUFU'S FUNERARY TREASURE

COULD THE FUNERARY TREASURE OF KHUFU STILL BE LYING BENEATH THE GREAT PYRAMID?

Impressive and majestic, the Great Pyramid of Giza, the only one of the Seven Wonders of the World still standing, has towered over Egypt for centuries. But a mystery remains: this colossal pyramid appears to be empty. Neither King Khufu's mummy nor his treasure have ever been found.

After researchers claimed to have found an "underground city" 600 meters deep beneath the pyramids of Giza in March 2025, the question arises: Could the tomb of Khufu be hidden under the Great pyramid - built during his reign?

Following the course of the Nile with leading international experts, and retracing the steps of the most iconic pharaohs, we set out in search of the treasure of Khufu. We will explore the king's pyramid, its interior, and iconic tombs, with the idea of a hidden treasure in the background, whose contours and location will be discussed with archaeological and editorial rigor.



Caligula. He only ruled the Roman Empire for 4 years, he was one of the most controversial Roman leaders in History, his name is a household word, synonymous with excess and tyranny, but was he really?

Recent archaeological discoveries allow us to reassess the legacy of this controversial emperor: the floating palaces found under Lake Nemi, the temple of Castor and Pollux, and in 2024 the discovery of the ruins of the imperial garden in Rome. UNCOVER THE ARCHITECTURAL FEAT BEHIND THE MYTHICAL TOWER OF BABEL

In the second millennium BCE, in the heart of Babylon, the most famous city from ancient Mesopotamia, King Hammurabi launched a colossal project: the construction of the Etemenanki ziggurat, a gigantic tower intended to link the world of men with that of the gods.

Spanning over a thousand years of construction, this monument was a triumph of architecture and engineering: 90 meters wide by 90 meters high, seven levels crowned with a temple of six chapels, and visible from dozens of kilometers away. A symbol of Babylon's power, the Etemenanki inspired the biblical tale of the Tower of Babel – and ultimately shared its tragic fate.

But where does the universal myth end, and where does historical truth begin? With the insights of international experts, and thanks to 3D modeling and Algenerated animations, this film attempts to unravel the secrets of the tallest tower in all Antiquity, and of the legendary megacity that raised it.

In 1066, William, Duke of Normandy, launched the largest sea invasion of the Middle Ages in order to seize the English crown by force. This decision would trigger the greatest military invasion of the medieval world and change the course of European history forever.

THE GENIUS COUPLE WHO SECRETLY CREATED THE FRENCH ATOMIC BOMB

The story of the French atomic bomb is one of the Republic's best-kept secrets. Behind this epic story, which began with the discovery of artificial radioactivity and culminated in the dropping of the first French atomic bomb in Algeria, lies a couple of geniuses: Irène and Frédéric Joliot-Curie.


A BEHIND-THE-SCENES LOOK AT AN OVERSHADOWED TRIAL

In 1946, while the world focused on Nuremberg, another historic trial was unfolding in Tokyo to prosecute leaders of Imperial Japan. Yet, this trial remains largely forgotten, despite the horrific Pacific War that claimed nearly twenty million lives. Why was this trial overshadowed?

This documentary uncovers how the Tokyo Trial, meant to establish international justice after the war, was manipulated by the United States to serve its interests against the USSR. By sparing Emperor Hirohito to secure Japan as a strategic ally, the Americans compromised the ideal of impartial justice. This flawed trial still leaves deep wounds today between Japan and its neighbors, particularly China and South Korea.

Drawing from never-before-seen archives of French judge Bernard, sent to Tokyo to represent France, this film takes viewers behind the scenes of a forgotten trial. Expert interviews, restored footage, and untold stories reveal a clash between justice and politics, challenging our ability to truly learn from history.

THE NAZIS' CUT AND RUN

HUNTED BY THE ALLIES AFTER WWII, MANY NAZIS ESCAPED OUT EUROPE SECRETLY HELPED BY THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

At the end of WWII, Europe was in chaos, still haunted by the horrors of Holocaust, but determined to bring the Nazis to justice. The Allies compiled a list of approximately 30,000 war criminals which triggered a worldwide hunt of an unprecedented scale.

This turn of events caused many Nazis to attempt to flee the European continent. Secret networks were created that enabled between 5,000 and 10,000 of them to escape capture. Among them, were some of the most notorious: Dr. Josef Mengele, Auschwitz's "Angel of Death"; Adolf Eichmann, a key figure in the "Final Solution" genocide; Franz Stangl, who oversaw the Sobibor and Treblinka extermination camps; and Klaus Barbie, known as the "Butcher of Lyon". The search for these criminals has long been part of our collective speculation, fueling mysteries and theories. But the truth behind their escape from justice is almost unimaginable because they were aided by a powerful and surprising ally: the Catholic Church.

Probing the intricate network that helped Nazis flee via "ratlines", also known as "the monastery road", this documentary reveals how and why the Church played such a key role in their escape.



HOW THE CATHOLIC CHURCH COVERED MICHELANGELO'S PAINTINGS

In 1563, Michelangelo's *The Last Judgment* was targeted by the Catholic Church's first official censorship based on perceptions of scandalous imagery and intended indecency. This monumental fresco, illustrated with naked bodies, had caused a shockwave throughout Europe. But, behind this scandal, a much larger war was being waged: the battle for authority and control over art.

This film explores the fundamental tensions of the Renaissance through this masterpiece and investigates artistic freedom versus authority, celebrating the body versus fears of desire, and conservative faith versus aesthetic choices. It reveals how Michelangelo, by painting naked flesh, touched the untouchable. Through him, we discover the reality of soft religious power and the dramatic beginnings of artistic censorship.

Incorporating expert analysis by art historians and biographers, and delving into archives and correspondence, we'll conduct a meticulous visual exploration of the fresco and a sensitive reinterpretation of its context. This documentary offers a new perspective on this iconic, legendary work and the history of Catholic censorship.

A MAJOR ARCHAEOLOGICAL PROJECT TO BRING A WAR-TORN IRAQI CITY BACK TO LIFE

Spring 2024, Mosul is buzzing with activity. Gigantic works are underway to rebuild what was destroyed: An entire city. Particular monuments are at the heart of the site's efforts and those of the scientific teams. Starting with the famous Al-Hadba leaning minaret, a national landmark that set the pace of life in the city since the 12th century, until it was partially demolished during war. But also the Al-Nuri mosque and the Al-Tahera church.

How do you revive the spirit of Mosul? How do you rebuild an entire city? While the war has taken its toll, it has also rekindled a common feeling: awareness of the incredible wealth of Mosul's heritage. And the need for the city to rise from its ashes.

Since the early 2000s, auction houses have been buzzing with activity, with sacred manuscripts getting snatched up at gold prices by private collectors and the world's greatest museums. THE RISE OF A MULTINATIONAL DRUG CARTEL IN THE HEART OF EUROPE

Between 2019 and 2024, the largest criminal trial in Dutch history unfolded inside a heavily fortified courtroom in the suburbs of Amsterdam: the Marengo Trial. It exposed the inner workings of an ultra-violent, hyper-connected criminal organization, born from an alliance between street criminals, businessmen, cartel bosses and mafia figures. This unprecedented case laid bare a phenomenon rooted in the Netherlands that is now spreading across Europe.

Why has this new form of criminal power taken root in the Netherlands? By tracing the deep history of drug trafficking in Europe, this film exposes the colonial roots of the trade, the contradictions of Dutch drug policy, and the impact of globalization on a booming illicit market. It also questions the myths surrounding this "new mafia" and the limits of democratic states faced with such underground empires.

This in-depth investigation draws on rare archives and interviews with journalists, criminologists and customs officers. It offers a gripping dive into the criminal economy, at the crossroads of colonial legacy, unbridled capitalism and the erosion of the rule of law. The film sheds light on a relentless fight waged by law enforcement, showing it is no longer just a matter of security - it's a societal crisis.

IRAN'S HOSTAGE-TAKING STRATEGY TO OBTAIN THE ATOMIC BOMB

The covert history of Iran's nuclear project dates back to the 1970s, with its main bias being hostage-taking. In the name of Iran's war of influence, and its absolute quest for the atom, Westerners were kidnapped. Locked up for years, they endured a truly horrifying ordeal in dreadful conditions of detention.

This was all part of a clever underground strategy masterminded by the Iranian mullahs and Lebanese militias. This secret plan mobilized all the Western secret services in a Beirut that had become a nest of spies amid the fracas of a fratricidal war. This story is at the heart of contemporary and future geopolitics, without anyone knowing anything about it. How did the Iranians use kidnapping to get what they wanted during the negotiations?

With the stories of each hostage, the forces of law and order, archives and evocations, the series will recount the details and implications of 4 hostage-takings of different nationalities, with the same sponsor in common: Iran.



CHASING HYDROGEN

IS NATURAL HYDROGEN REALLY THE ENERGY OF THE FUTURE?

Over the past few years, hydrogen has become a real social issue, with more and more reports on the subject and its use spreading in both transport and aerospace. But while its industrial production comes at the cost of heavy pollution, the discovery of natural hydrogen reservoirs around the world is raising hopes of an energy transition away from fossil fuels.

But what do we really know about this gas? What role does it play in the cycle of life? Is it a finite or renewable resource? Sometimes described as a miracle solution to the climate crisis, sometimes as an ecological mirage, natural hydrogen is above all a mystery, for the general public and researchers alike.

The race is on to expand our knowledge on hydrogen, before the industry gets hold of it. Current scientific missions promise a better understanding of our planet's mechanisms, at a time when it is crucial to reconcile the exploitation of resources with the preservation of living organisms.

XENOGRAFTS: THE FUTURE OF SCIENCE?

WITH THE LACK OF DONORS, XENOTRANSPLANTATION CAN BE A SOLUTION TO SAVE MORE HUMAN LIVES

In 2022, surgeons at the University of Maryland Medical School achieved a medical miracle with the first successful transplant of a heart from a genetically modified pig into a man with incurable heart disease. Three years later, a woman - Towana Looney broke records by becoming the first recipient of a pig kidney to live for more than two months.

Faced with a lack of donors, science is now considering transplanting an animal organ into a human. The risks of rejection and infection are among the many scientific challenges to be overcome. Other essential questions arise: Where is the ethical limit on manipulating the boundaries between humans and animals? Does the future of xenografts lie in breeding genetically modified pigs, or in growing human organs in pig bodies? What would be the consequences for the pig graft market?

In the USA, over 100,000 patients are currently waiting for an organ transplant. Every day in Europe, 18 patients who are candidates for organ transplants die for lack of donor organs. This scientific investigation reveals the inner workings of these medical advances, with their considerable ethical, human and economic consequences.
