

KRISTALLNACHT: THE NAZI FURY

THE 3 DAYS THAT CHANGED THE FATE OF JEWS IN GERMANY AND EUROPE

Paris, November 7, 1938. Herschel Grynszpan, a young Jewish refugee, murdered the third secretary of the German embassy, Ernst vom Rath. This event was the pretext for unleashing an unprecedented wave of anti-Semitic violence on the night of 9-10 November and the following day.

On Reich territory, more than 200 synagogues were burnt down and destroyed, thousands of shops vandalized and private flats ransacked. Hundreds of Jews attacked died or committed suicide, and 30,000 were deported to concentration camps. The night became known as "Kristallnacht" ("the Night of Broken Glass"), due to the litter of broken glass left in the streets the next day. A euphemism that reduces events to a simple riot or mere property damage. Yet this was the very first pogrom in German history. A turning point in the regime's opression of the Jews. A prelude to the Holocaust...

Combining archive footage and historians' insights, this film deciphers these terrible events, its challenges and consequences, and shows how those 3 days forever changed the fate of Jews in Germany and Europe.

THE NAZIS' CUT AND RUN

HUNTED BY THE ALLIES AFTER WWII, MANY NAZIS ESCAPED OUT EUROPE SECRETLY HELPED BY THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

At the end of World War II, Europe was a continent in ruins, haunted by the horrors of the Holocaust, determined to bring the Nazis to justice. The Allies compiled a list of some 30,000 war criminals, triggering a hunt on an unprecedented scale.

Facing this situation, Nazis sought to flee Europe. Secrets exfiltration networks were set up, enabling many of them - between 5 and 10,000 - to escape justice. Among them, were some of the most wanted Nazis: Dr. Josef Mengele, Auschwitz's "Angel of Death"; Adolf Eichmann, a key figure in the genocidal "Final Solution"; Franz Stangl, in charge of the Sobibor and Treblinka extermination camps; and Klaus Barbie, also known as the "Butcher of Lyon".

For decades, these hunts have been part of the collective imagination, fueling incredible speculation. But the truth is that these war criminals on the run were helped by an ally as unexpected as it was powerful: the Catholic Church. Diving into the intricacies of the networks that helped the fleeing Nazis via the "ratlines", this documentary deciphers how and why the Church played a key role in this massive escape.

THE DISCOVERY OF 2,400-YEAR-OLD MALE MILITARY LOVERS RAISES CONTEMPORARY ISSUES

Can ancient history raise modern questions about masculinity?

This is the untold saga of the world's greatest military fighting force, made up of 150 pairs of male lovers, whose story has just been uncovered. This elite Greek army called the "Sacred Band" was formed by the city of Thebes in 379 BCE to defend itself from Sparta. Fighting undefeated for four decades, the army was annihilated by the forces of Philip II of Macedon and his son Alexander in the Battle of Chaeronea. Buried on the battlefield where they fell, the 300 were forgotten by History, until a Greek archaeologist discovered the mass grave in 1880. Yet the discovery was never made public and the grave was covered up, leading some historians to claim that the Sacred Band never existed. But in 2022, they've finally been re-discovered, lying in pairs. A team of international archaeologists is reexamining the new evidences, gaining unprecedented insight into their story.

This is a story rooted in ancient history which highlights contemporary topics such as same-sex marriage, the place of gay soldiers in the military, the human consequences of war, and the struggle between democratic and authoritarian political systems.

CAPRICIOUS MEGALOMANIAC, CRUEL TYRANT OR VISIONARY ARCHITECTURAL GENIUS, WHO REALLY WAS CALIGULA?

Caligula. He only ruled the Roman Empire for 4 years, he was one of the most controversial Roman leaders in History, his name is a household word, synonymous with excess and tyranny, but was he really?

Recent archaeological discoveries allow us to reassess the legacy of this controversial emperor: the floating palaces found under Lake Nemi, the temple of Castor Pollux, and in 2024 the discovery of the ruins of the imperial garden in Rome. Why did he undertake such outrageous projects? How could he orchestrate the transport of a colossal obelisk to the heart of Rome? How did these floating palaces mark underwater archaeology?

Through expert analysis and 3D modeling, we explore these impressive achievements. By meticulously tracing the construction process, this miniseries reveals how Caligula left an architectural legacy that defies simplistic and caricatured perceptions of the emperor's personality.

THE GENIUS COUPLE WHO SECRETLY CREATED THE FRENCH ATOMIC BOMB

The story of the French atomic bomb is one of the Republic's best-kept secrets. Behind this epic story, which began with the discovery of artificial radioactivity and culminated in the dropping of the first French atomic bomb in Algeria, lies a couple of geniuses: Irène and Frédéric Joliot-Curie.

It's an extraordinary adventure, rarely told, spanning the tormented years between the wars, the Second World War and the Cold War, with its division of the world into two blocs. THE LITTLE-KNOWN EPISODE THAT MADE MARILYN MONROE A TRUE STAR: HER USO TOUR IN KOREA

In February 1954, Marilyn Monroe interrupted her honeymoon in Japan with Joe DiMaggio and flew to a warn-torn Korea, invited by the American army to do a tour intended to cheer up the GIs.

During those four days, she sang in front of more than 100,000 soldiers, exhausted by three years of fighting against the communist forces. Overcoming the freezing cold and her stage fright, she performed her signature songs, such as "Diamonds are A Girl's Best Friend", over the course of 10 shows. For Marilyn Monroe, it was a defining moment. By performing on stage for the very first time, she would meet her American audience, but also reveal herself. Later, she would say it was the first she ever "felt like a star".

Thanks to fully restored archive footage, this film dives into a little-known yet pivotal episode in the life and career of Marilyn Monroe. Through this journey, it's also the story of the Korean War and the portrait of a profoundly anti-communist America that are revealed to us.

ENTER THE CORRIDORS OF UKRAINIAN DIPLOMACY WITH THE YOUNG MINISTER FOR EUROPE AND NATO

Olha Stefanishyna is a woman with high ideals and the courage to fight for them - even when they are literally under attack. Her pro-European will was awakened during the Maidan protests, and when nine years later - now as Deputy Prime Minister with the responsibility for Ukraine's campaign for EU membership - she receives the call that Russia has invaded the country in 2022, she sends her children to safety and boards a train to help President Zelensky lead the country through war - and into the EU and NATO.

With full access to Stefanishyna, Swedish documentarian Viktor Nordenskiöld is by her side in the dramatic years that followed. *The EUkrainian* is a journey into a labyrinth of EU politics, diplomacy and ideological minefields.

While Ukrainian forces bravely struggle to hold off Russian invaders, Olha races against time to meet the EU's strict criteria. She confronts corruption and judicial reform, but also internal opposition from Hungary and an unpredictable US. Meanwhile, the rest of Europe holds its breath.

A MAFIA-LIKE, TERRORIST AND OLIGARCHIC SYSTEM OWNED BY THE PASDARAN WHO EXERCISE ABSOLUTE CONTROL OVER IRAN

They are the protectors of the Islamic Republic of Iran, the armed arm of the Supreme Leader. A military organization of 120,000 men that has become tentacular, the Islamic Revolutionary Guards Corps (IRGC), also known as the Pasdaran, are now the Deep State. A true "state mafia" in Iran, they repress the people in blood.

Virtuosos of smuggling and trafficking, their economic empire is worth hundreds of billions of dollars. The Supreme Leader has gradually opened the doors of power to them, so that today the IRGC are mayors, deputies and ministers, cultivating their networks at the highest levels. The Pasdaran, who are responsible for Iran's nuclear and ballistic missile programs, cultivate not only the art of deterrence, but also a strategy of asymmetrical warfare through the militias and terrorist organizations they finance, arm and control in the Middle East.

This two-part film, combining the stories of individuals crushed by this ruthless machine with the accounts of political players and the Pasdaran themselves, reveals the power of a little-known organization, which nonetheless holds Iran's fate in its hands.

The covert history of Iran's nuclear project dates back to the 1970s, with its main bias being hostage-taking. A MAJOR ARCHAEOLOGICAL PROJECT TO BRING A WAR-TORN IRAQI CITY BACK TO LIFE

Spring 2024, Mosul is buzzing with activity. Gigantic works are underway to rebuild what was destroyed: An entire city. Particular monuments are at the heart of the site's efforts and those of the scientific teams. Starting with the famous Al-Hadba leaning minaret, a national landmark that set the pace of life in the city since the 12th century, until it was partially demolished during war. But also the Al-Nuri mosque and the Al-Tahera church.

How do you revive the spirit of Mosul? How do you rebuild an entire city? While the war has taken its toll, it has also rekindled a common feeling: awareness of the incredible wealth of Mosul's heritage. And the need for the city to rise from its ashes.

With exceptional access to the construction sites, we follow this titanic reconstruction step by step, mobilizing Iraqi locals, site managers and international scientists - supported by UNESCO, the Louvre Museum, the Swiss ALIPH Foundation, the British Museum and the American Smithsonian Institute.

A GREAT ARCHAEOLOGICAL ADVENTURE TO REFIND THE UNSUSPECTED TRACKS OF AMAZONIAN PEOPLE

In the middle of the Colombian forest, majestic mountains emerge from the canopy, and on their cliffs, thousands of rock paintings are traced in red pigment. Animals, warriors, geometric symbols... bear witness to a very ancient settlement and an unsuspected culture.

Initial research has revealed unexpected dates ranging from -10,000 to -19,000 years. This would make them among the oldest traces on the American continent! By following in the footsteps of these "first" men, will researchers be able to sketch out a new chronology of human occupation in Amazonia?



Over the past few years, hydrogen has become a real social issue, with more and more reports on the subject and its use spreading in both transport and aerospace. But while its industrial production comes at the cost of heavy pollution, the discovery of natural hydrogen reservoirs around the world is raising hopes of an energy transition away from fossil fuels.

But what do we really know about this gas? What role does it play in the cycle of life? Is it a finite or renewable resource? Sometimes described as a miracle solution to the climate crisis, sometimes as an ecological mirage, natural hydrogen is above all a mystery, for the general public and researchers alike.

The race is on to expand our knowledge on hydrogen, before the industry gets hold of it. Current scientific missions promise a better understanding of our planet's mechanisms, at a time when it is crucial to reconcile the exploitation of resources with the preservation of living organisms.

WITH THE LACK OF DONORS, XENOTRANSPLANTATION CAN BE A SOLUTION TO SAVE MORE HUMAN LIVES


In 2022, surgeons at the University of Maryland Medical School achieved a medical miracle with the first successful transplant of a heart from a genetically modified pig into a man with incurable heart disease. Three years later, a woman - Towana Looney - broke records by becoming the first recipient of a pig kidney to live for more than two months.

Faced with a lack of donors, science is now considering transplanting an animal organ into a human. The risks of rejection and infection are among the many scientific challenges to be overcome. Other essential questions arise: Where is the ethical limit on manipulating the boundaries between humans and animals? Does the future of xenografts lie in breeding genetically modified pigs, or in growing human organs in pig bodies? What would be the consequences for the pig graft market?

In the USA, over 100,000 patients are currently waiting for an organ transplant. Every day in Europe, 18 patients who are candidates for organ transplants die for lack of donor organs. This scientific investigation reveals the inner workings of these medical advances, with their considerable ethical, human and economic consequences.

AFTER THE HEAT: TRIASSIC DRAGONS

THE QUEST FOR THE LARGEST ANIMAL THAT EVER LIVED

The recent discovery of a gigantic fossilized ichthyosaur tooth root in the Swiss Alps, dating from 208 million years ago, has led one palaeontologist to suggest that it belongs to a predator measuring about 36 meters long.

If the existence of this creature is confirmed, it would be the largest animal of all time. Its extraordinary size raises many questions about the food resources that would have been required to feed a Leviathan such as this and its descendants.

By scouring the sedimentary layers from the era of the dinosaurs in excavation sites, several teams of paleontologists are gradually unearthing answers. They are discovering, not just complete fossil remains of other ichthyosaurs that ruled the oceans for 130 million years, but also of their potential prey. Using innovative tools for analysis, they are reconstructing these giants' biology, anatomy and environment... and estimating the staggering sizes they attained.
